“The Innovation Center: Increasing Readiness for College”

We face profound challenges in education from an increasingly technology-driven, globalized world:

- The US is ranked 30th out of 34 developed nations in math, and 15th in literacy.
- US colleges and universities spend about \$6 billion per year on remedial education: too many high school students are not prepared for college.



Dr. Christopher Winters will address these issues. We do not expect him to solve our nation’s education problems, but perhaps his Innovation Lab at Greenwich High School might be part of the solution.

Dr. Winters has a deep understanding of Greenwich schools. He is now the Headmaster at Greenwich High School following positions as Folsom Housemaster at Greenwich High School (2006-2007), Coordinator of the English as a Second Language Program (1999-2006), and Coordinator of the World Language Program (2003-2006).

His career in education began in 1990 as an ESL teacher at Morris High School (the Bronx) after two years in the Peace Corps (the Republic of Mali, West Africa). In 1998 he moved to Roxbury Elementary School (Stamford, CT).

Dr. Winters received his Ph.D. in education at the University of Connecticut; his B.A. in Political Science from Middlebury College, in Vermont; his M.A. in TESOL and his Masters in Education both from Teachers College/Columbia University in New York City; his six year Degree in Administration from Sacred Heart University in Fairfield, CT; and Superintendent Certification from the UConn’s Executive Leadership Program.
