Curtis Fisher

Offshore Wind Energy in Connecticut and Beyond



In order to confront increasing temperatures and floods, rising sea levels, and other serious impacts from climate change, Connecticut like many other northeast states is advancing new clean and renewable technologies to replace fossil fuels. Curtis Fisher will discuss one of Connecticut's most exciting options, offshore wind. After providing a background on this technology, he will cover the economics involved, the pros and cons for its use, and the opportunity for CT ports to develop projects in New England and the NY metro area.

Since 2008, Curtis Fisher has been the Northeast Region's Executive Director of the National Wildlife Federation, leading the organization's work in New York, New Jersey and New England. He is devoted to combating climate change, jump-starting a clean energy economy, safeguarding wildlife and natural resources, and connecting people with nature. With a law degree from University of Oregon, he has had several roles in New Jersey politics and policy, including: Chief of Staff, New Jersey Department of the Public Advocate; Policy Counselor for Corzine in his successful gubernatorial campaign; Deputy Policy Director, Office of the New Jersey Governor; and Executive Director, New Jersey Public Interest Research Group. Most recently, he was Deputy Policy Director for New Jersey Phil Murphy's transition team. He is the recipient of a Sierra Club Achievement Award.
