“Building the New NY Bridge Over The Tappan Zee”



The replacement for the aging Tappan Zee Bridge is an immense, much-needed and costly project that will shape traffic patterns, commuting delays and aesthetics over the Hudson River for decades. It will have a dual-span design, which will be the widest in the world. Construction will take about five years. The \$4 billion highway bridge project is the largest in North America.

This presentation will give a project overview, the impacts on the region, the current timeline of the project, what has been done so far, what are the environmental aspects and mitigation efforts, what's happening now and what you will see in the future. We show a couple of timely videos and provide lots of facts.

Dan Marcy has been a member of the New NY Bridge Project's outreach team for since 2012. In that time, the outreach team has held more than 700 meetings with residents, community groups, business associations, elected officials and other stakeholders. Prior to the New NY Bridge project, Dan was a project manager at Empire State Development. Mr. Marcy received a Bachelor's Degree in Economics from Tufts University
