“Fiscal Policy To Spur Economic Growth”

The last few years have raised strikingly different views of how to manage governmental budgets and the national debt and to grow the economy. The



Congressional Budget Office advises the Congress through deep economic studies of these issues. The CBO is the independent federal agency responsible for nonpartisan analysis. The RMA is pleased to present Dr. Elmendorf who led the Director of the Congressional Budget Office from 2009 to 2015. He knows how to make federal budget numbers consistent and realistic. At the RMA he will discuss

his experience and ideas about putting federal debt on a sustainable path and suggest specific changes in spending and tax policies.

In January of 2016 he will become the Dean of the well-regarded Harvard Kennedy School of Government. Before his stint heading the Congressional Budget Office, he was an Assistant Professor at Harvard University, a senior economist at the White House Council of Economic Advisers, and held senior positions at the Treasury Department, the Federal Reserve Board and the Brookings Institution.

“As director of the CBO, he won widespread praise for his leadership and management skills, his integrity and fairness, his intellectual curiosity and analytical acuity, and his ability to work thoughtfully and constructively with people across the political spectrum,” said Harvard President Drew Faust.

Dr. Elmendorf earned his B.A. Summa Cum Laude from Princeton University and his M.A. and Ph.D. from Harvard University. He is the son-in-law of the RMA’s very own Bill Dynan. This is his second presentation to the RMA.
