Henry Alexander Dorochovich

“Climate Change and America’s National Security”

The science of global warming and the reality of a changing climate are leading governments & other organizations to assess potential impacts on national security.

Henry Alexander Dorochovich, former senior CIA Directorate of Science and Technology officer, will present a brief overview of the science of global warming, followed by a review of the issues, impacts, and implications of the effects of climate change on our country’s national security. An outline of the U.S. Government’s recent efforts to understand these impacts, with a primary concentration on the Intelligence and Defense Communities, will be followed by a discussion about the range of Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) that are focusing significant efforts on these issues. A discussion of the implications for the future will include sea level rise/flooding, drought, food shortages and the huge potential for mass migration, with resultant instability and regional conflicts creating possible scenarios for security problems.



Hank Dorochovich is a volunteer Project Leader trained by former Vice President Al Gore and the Climate Reality Project. He retired from the Central Intelligence Agency in 2011, having served over 31 years with the CIA. His primary activities included the acquisition and launch of reconnaissance satellites for the National Reconnaissance Office. He also spent considerable time in assignments in satellite and ground station operations as a Mission Director and in systems engineering and research & development.

In one of his last assignments, Mr. Dorochovich served as an Inspector in the CIA’s Office of Inspector General, evaluating CIA components, programs, and issues. He was team leader for the first-ever inspection of the Directorate of Operations’ Iran Operations Division. His travels included the war zones in Iraq and Afghanistan.
