Fairfield County's Community Foundation promotes philanthropy as a means to create change in Fairfield County, focusing on innovative and collaborative solutions to critical issues impacting the community. The Community Foundation was founded in 1992 when five smaller foundations merged-- Danbury, Greenwich, Stamford, Five Town (comprised of Westport, Wilton, Weston, Norwalk and Darien) and the Fairfield County Foundation -- to better serve their communities and Fairfield County. Thanks to the generosity of fundholders and contributors, it has awarded \$180 million in grants to nonprofits throughout Fairfield County and beyond.

Ms. James joined the Foundation as President and CEO in October, 2011 following a 37-year corporate career. Most recently, she served as chief marketing and communications officer at Pitney Bowes Inc., where she was responsible for marketing, brand management, media and analyst relations and corporate citizenship and philanthropy. She is deeply engaged in nonprofit leadership, helping local and national organizations navigate change and transformation. She is a trustee of UConn, Lesley University and trustee emerita of Princeton University. Juanita has been a director for Reading Is Fundamental and, locally, has held board leadership roles for Stamford Museum and Nature Center, Stamford Symphony, Childcare Learning and the Ferguson Library, and has been a director for Curtain Call. She is an ordained elder and deacon of First Presbyterian Church in Stamford. She holds a Master's degree in business policy from Columbia University's Graduate School of Business and earned her Bachelor's degree in romance languages from Princeton University. She and her husband, Dudley Williams, Jr., have lived in Stamford for 24 years and raised their son, Dudley Williams, III in the community.
