## **Laurence Kantor**

"Trade, Tax Reform, Immigration and Financial Markets, An Economist's View"



With the advent of a new Administration, it has been hard to escape the news swirling around such issues as immigration, international trade and tax reform. Many proposals and statements have been made, but what are the facts? And how would various proposals affect the economy? Where are we in the current business cycle, and what are the prospects for the economy and financial markets?

Please join us to hear Larry Kantor, who will draw on his many years as a senior leader in the financial industry to tackle these issues. Larry was a 2016 Advanced Leadership Institute Fellow at Harvard University, and recently retired as Managing Director and

Global Head of Research at Barclays. Based in New York, Larry was responsible for global research including economics, equities, interest rates, foreign exchange, emerging markets, credit and commodities. He was also a member of the investment bank Executive Committee and made numerous media appearances, including CNBC, Bloomberg TV and radio, The Nightly Business Report and CBS Evening News.

Larry joined Barclays in 2003 as Head of Economics and Market Strategy from JPMorgan Chase, where he was a Managing Director and Global Head of Foreign Exchange Strategy. Prior to that, he spent 7 years at Normandy Asset Management as Chief Economist and Market Strategist. Before that he was Chief Economist for Europe in London for JPMorgan and prior to that he was an economist at the Federal Reserve Board in Washington, DC where, among other things, he briefed the Board of Governors including the Fed Chairman. He began his career as an Assistant Professor of Economics at Lehigh University.

Larry received his PhD and MA in Economics from Ohio State University.
