“The Hard Parts About Assessing Taxes in Greenwich”

Specifically, she will explain the new assessment process, and describe some of the difficult decisions faced by the Assessor’s Office.

Greenwich now has an Assessor with over 30 years of experience in the tax assessment field. She was an assessor for many New England towns, including the City of Portsmouth NH. As a lawyer for over 8 years she litigated many appeals before the Massachusetts Appeals Board, has testified as an expert in both Connecticut and New Hampshire, and was director of the New England office for a national tax firm, covering real estate and personal property tax appeals.

Elliott graduated from Wheaton College in Norton, Massachusetts, earned her law degree at Western New England School of Law, and has an LLM in estate and gift tax.
