Pamela Kuhn, Opera Singer

“My Life as a Singer”



Are singers born or made? How are singers trained? Can one really control one's diaphragm? Is there a connection between body stature and vocal resonance? What about being tone deaf? What are the realities of being a professional singer? How do they preserve their voices? Operatic soprano Pamela Kuhn, our presenter, will answer these questions and more

Ms. Kuhn is a professional singer and voice teacher. After earning her master's degree at the University of Southern California, she based her career for twenty years in London. Her London recital debut was in 1985 with Graham Johnson at the Wigmore Hall. She has performed in opera houses and recital halls in Vienna, London, Venice, Paris, and cities across America. She has been coached by many distinguished artists and is herself a vocal coach to many professional singers, who perform in a variety of musical genres from opera to rock and roll.

Since her return to the United States, she has become recognized for her work as a voice teacher and mentor to young professional singers. In addition, she is a choral director, conducting the MasterSingers of Greenwich and the Silvertones at the Greenwich Senior Center. She takes particular pride in the Angel Choir, a singing group devoted to cancer patients, survivors and family members. Locally she conducts a radio program, “Center Stage with Pamela Kuhn” on WGCH Tuesday mornings at 9AM, interviewing a variety of individuals in all aspects of music and the arts.

Ms. Kuhn will describe her personal journey from small town girl to operatic diva, discuss the art of singing, and give a voice lesson to the audience which will culminate in a group sing. She will have her personal accompanist on the piano.
