“Greenwich Today”



First Selectman Peter J. Tesei will speak to the Retired Men’s Association of Greenwich. A fifth generation Greenwich resident, in his sixth term as First Selectman, Mr. Tesei will present his vision of the town’s future. He will discuss the effect of the State of Connecticut’s financial difficulties on the finances of the Town of Greenwich. He also will present a progress report on major town projects, including the care of the town’s senior citizens.

Peter was elected Greenwich First Selectman in November 2007. He was the youngest member in the history of the Representative Town Meeting, having been elected to that body in November 1987 at the age of 18. He served as the District 9 (Pemberwick/Glenville) Delegation Vice Chairman and Chairman until 1997. His service to the Town of Greenwich continued with his election to the Board of Estimate and Taxation in 1997. He served the BET for 10 years, including six as Chairman.

In addition to his governmental duties, Peter has served as a Board member of the United Way of Greenwich, American Red Cross Greenwich Chapter, and is currently a member of the Board of the Greenwich Council of the Boy Scouts of America, Greenwich Symphony Orchestra, American Red Cross Metro CT/NY. He serves on the Advisory Boards of The Breast Cancer Alliance, Community Centers Inc., and the Greenwich Alliance for Education.

He is a graduate of the University of Connecticut. Before serving as First Selectman, he worked in the financial services sector for almost twenty years, serving as a Vice President of the Wealth Management Group of BNY/Mellon. Peter and his wife Jill are the parents of a daughter, Caroline, and a son, James, who both attend Greenwich Public Schools.
