

WHAT IS THE RMA?

The RMA is a local organization for active men 55 years of age or older residing in Greenwich and immediate surrounding communities. Members share a keen interest in learning and socializing. Coming from diverse backgrounds, RMA members are united in their support of the RMA's mission: Fellowship, Volunteerism and Service to the Community. Volunteerism is actively encouraged and supported.

Organized in 1954, the Retired Men's Association of Greenwich, Inc. (RMA) has close to 250 members. More than 125 weekly have coffee, catch up on RMA news and listen to their interesting guest speakers.

RMA offers a variety of activities for members, including periodic day trips to cultural events like Goodspeed Opera House, Tanglewood and, for fun, Belmont Raceway. RMA organizes special picnics, luncheons, tennis, golf, hiking, bridge and opera viewings. A new Shakespeare study group and another of hearts card players have recently formed. The Melody Men are RMA's touring singing group. Participation in any activity is encouraged but not required.

Annual membership fees are around \$100. The Wednesday meetings start at 10:00AM and last approximately 40 minutes. At each weekly meeting, the RMA collects \$2 from each member attending. These funds primarily cover the cost of refreshments served between the end of the business meeting and the 11:00AM introduction of the speaker. All meetings end no later than noon.
