He is the Dental Consultant for Connecticut Health of Greenwich (nursing home and rehabilitation center) and has been on their board since 1985.

Dr. Aslanian has received the following awards for Community Service: Greenwich Health Association Award for Outstanding Volunteer Health Care professional for Lecturing to the Youth of Greenwich in anti-smoking education programs 1990, and Outstanding Health Services Professional of the year 2008, awarded by Abilis.
