Ambassador Tom Niles

“My Perspective on Foreign Affairs Today”



Ambassador Niles will call on the experience and insights he gained over 36 years in the United States Foreign Service, and subsequently in international relations, to try to unravel the causes and direction of the many foreign challenges facing the United States today. Two years ago he spoke to RMA about the challenges of Russia, which today require even more explication. But with unraveling in the EU, terrorism and warfare across much of the Middle East and Near East, renewed civil war in central Africa, a newly militant China and a fierce North Korea, he will have much to cover in this talk.

Ambassador Niles served as Ambassador to Canada (1985-89), Ambassador to the European Union (1989-91), Assistant Secretary of State for Europe and Canada (1991-93), and Ambassador to Greece (1993-97).

He has since served as President and Vice Chairman of the United States Council for International Business, which advances the global interests of American business both at home and abroad, promoting an open system of world trade, finance, and investment and is a member of the American Academy of Diplomacy. He is a resident of Greenwich.
