Beth Evans, Director of Environmental Affairs for The Town of Greenwich, will speak about the future of Greenwich's environment as it will impact our children and grandchildren, and our responsibility for working to insure their future health and wellbeing.

As Director of Environmental Affairs for our Town, Evans is responsible for the Conservation Commission and the Inlands Wetlands & Watercourses Agency. She is a professional wetlands scientist, field biologist, wildlife biologist, grandmother.

Previously Evans ran an environmental consulting business which she founded in 1988.

Evans holds a Master's Degree in Regional Planning and a Master of Science in Geology from the University of Pennsylvania, and a BA in Biology from Cornell University. Evans lives in Bethany, Connecticut.
