## **Bettina Wohlforth, AuD**

### **“I Think I Have a Hearing Problem, Now What Do I Do?”**

There are approximately 48 million people in the United States who experience some degree of hearing loss. Have you ever been in a situation where you couldn't follow the conversation or presentation and wondered if everyone else was experiencing the same difficulty? Do you often ask people to repeat themselves or



worse yet nod in agreement when you have no clue what you are agreeing to? If your answer is yes, it could be time for a comprehensive hearing test and possibly hearing aids. Bettina Wohlforth, AuD, will discuss basic ear anatomy, the hearing test and what it tells us, and current hearing aid options.

Dr. Wohlforth is a clinical audiologist with 34 years of experience. She was primary clinical audiologist at Greenwich Hospital Hearing, Speech and Language Center for 27 years performing diagnostic hearing evaluations and hearing aid prescriptions and fittings. In 2011 when Greenwich Hospital eliminated audiological services she went into private practice in Greenwich.

She holds a Clinical Doctorate in Audiology from the Arizona School of Health Science, Mesa, Arizona and bachelors and masters degrees from Adelphi University. She is a member of the American Academy of Audiology and the American Speech, Language and Hearing Association.

Dr. Wohlforth is a frequent speaker to local groups in the Fairfield County area.
