TODAY'S SPEAKER

JOEL BLUMBERG introduced Dr. Bruce McGibbon, who spoke on "Advances in Radiation for Cancer." Dr. McGibbon, Director of Radiation Therapy at Greenwich Hospital, revealed the exciting new means of treating cancer with pin-point accuracy. Cancers of the breast, prostate, brain and lung can be treated with no discomfort to the patient. Ionized radiation breaks up the chemical bonds that form cancers. Dr. McGibbon said the treatment is a team effort from

the front desk preparing the patient to the Radiation Therapist who positions the patient on the Radiation Machine, designated LINACE.

Using a computer imaging the radiation beam, less than 1/8 of an inch, is guided accurately to the malignancy. After several treatments the malignancy is gone. Skin cancers including those on eyelids can be treated safely. The success rate of RT is 90% vs 70% using previous methods. Dr. McGibbon's talk was well presented with excellent graphic illustrations.

Note: This writer can attest to the success of RT having undergone treatment for cancer in his lower spinal column. The cancer was removed, and the T-12 vertebrae grew back in a remarkably short time.
