TODAY'S SPEAKER

HOLLISTER STURGES and BOB RIMMER introduced today's speaker as Dr. Alan Barry Ph.D. Greenwich's Commissioner of Human Resources. His topic was "Safety Net to Self Sufficiency Narrowing the Wealth Gap." He spoke of income inequality stating that the top 10% of people in our country hold more wealth than the lower 90% combined. The Greenwich Human Resources Department deals with housing, shelter, food, clothing and financial assistance for those who qualify and live in Greenwich. They also deal with home care for disabled clients. Our own ALAN GUNZBURG is Vice President, reporting to Dr. Barry, who indicated that he poverty rate in Greenwich is 6% and that it is highest among African Americans, about 12%. He stated that the middle class in the United States has been "hollowed out."
