TODAY'S SPEAKER

JERRY SCHWENDEMAN introduced today's speaker Kai Harada, to speak on "A Sound Designer's Journey to Broadway." Mr. Harada is a Tony Award winner and a native of Greenwich. Among his contributions are "Wicked" and "Million Dollar Quartet."

'Sound design" in musical theater is focused on "reinforcement", not simply amplification.

In recent years, audience expectations have changed in step with increasing electric instrumentation, changes in actor training and changes in venue design. Younger writers, composers and directors are eager to overcome potential deficits in natural acoustics. ("There are no more Ethel Mermans")

The sound designer answers to producers, script writers, cast, directors and "music supervisors." Mr. Hirada uses his experience in 'Million Dollar Quartet"--a 2008-2010 production reviving a night when Elvis Presley, Johnny Cash, Jerry Lee Lewis and Carl Perkins performed together.

After a brief video, he takes us through a step-by-step journey to getting this performance successfully to Broadway, specifically from a sound designer's point of view, including the details of placing microphones, "technical rehearsals" on site, and audience previews. In the end, adept use of "politics and psychology" is critical.
