



Dr. George Ubogy

Moderates "The Doctor Is In," a Panel Discussion by four Physicians



Have you ever wondered if you have asked your doctor the right questions about a health problem? Do you feel there are key medical questions you should have asked? How candid and forthcoming are your conversations with your physician?

Dr. George Ubogy will lead a discussion on the doctor/patient relationship. The panel includes three other retired Greenwich physicians: an internist, a surgeon, and an orthopedist

The panel will answer questions most frequently asked by their patients, plus questions they wished that their patients had asked. They will also discuss how to optimize one's office visit or hospital experience, and will address some of the changes in medical care to expect during the next decade.

Dr. Ubogy is a retired internist and the former Medical Director of the Greenwich Hospital Addiction Recovery Center; Dr. Spike Lipschutz is the Physician-In-Chief of Greenwich Hospital; Dr. Frank Scarpa is a retired general and vascular surgeon; and Dr. John Crowe is a retired orthopedist and the co-founder, with Dr. Ed Jones, Jr., of ONS (Orthopedic and Neurosurgery Specialists).

After discussing the questions asked by patients, the doctors will respond directly to questions from the audience in a robust Q&A.
