"Major Issues surrounding the 2020 Tokyo Olympics"



Double Olympic gold-medalist and Emmy award winning sports and news broadcaster Donna de Varona will join David Weisbrod in a conversation about issues confronting the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and beyond. Ms. de Varona has been a go to advisor in the US Senate on major legislation dealing with education, such as title IX of the 1972 Equal Education Amendments Act and in 1978 the passage of the Amateur and Olympic Sports Act. She also is a founding board member of Special Olympics international and is currently serving on the international Olympic Committee women sports commission. She is an inductee into the Seneca Women's Hall of Fame and the US Olympic Committee Hall of Fame. Last week she received the highest honor from the US Olympic and Paralympic committee, the torch award.
