Gregory Kramer, Ph.D.

“Managing Greenwich’s Parks and Trees”



As the Superintendent of Parks and Trees and Tree Warden for the Town of Greenwich, Dr. Gregory Kramer is responsible for the protection and management of trees on town property. He will discuss the care and nurturing of these treasured resources and his ambitious plans to inventory the 65,000 trees that populate our parks, traffic islands and open spaces. He oversees the health of trees on over 1500 acres of public land and is charged with planting new trees. He also arbitrates disputes between public and private interests on matters of removing trees from town owned property. In fulfilling

his responsibilities, Dr. Kramer has enhanced private/public partnerships in the Town of Greenwich.

Dr. Kramer has over 25 years of professional experience in horticulture. Prior to coming to Greenwich, he was Director of Horticulture at Bok Tower Gardens in Florida. He has a B.A. in biology from the University of Miami, an M.S. in Environmental Horticulture, and a DMP in Plant Medicine from the University of Florida. His areas of expertise are plant diseases, landscape design, and habitat design.
