## **Congressman Jim Himes**

### **“Conversation with Rep. Jim Himes about the new Congress and Biden Administration”**



U.S. House Representative Jim Himes will discuss the challenges facing the 117<sup>th</sup> Congress and the newly elected Biden administration. At least four major crises face the nation: the COVID-19 pandemic, job loss and economic recession, climate change, and racial injustice. Congressman Himes will work with a Democratic majority on how government will respond to these challenges. Legislative priorities for the current session include the following:

- pass the covid relief plan which includes stimulus payments, extending unemployment benefits, and increased funding for the national vaccine program.
- expand and improve the Affordable Care Act.
- reduce prescription drug prices.
- pass the John Lewis Voting Rights Act to make voting easier and to protect people from voter suppression.
- enhance background checks on firearms.
- pass the Equality Act to prohibit discrimination based on sex, gender identity and sexual orientation.
- pass the Paycheck Fairness Act to secure equal pay for equal work.
- establish independent, nonpartisan redistricting commissions.
- address campaign finance reform.
- combat and address climate change.
- support manufacturers, businesses and workers to ensure that our future is made in America by all of America's workers.

Jim represents Connecticut's 4th Congressional District. He currently serves as a member of the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence where he is Chairman of the Strategic Technologies and Advanced Research (STAR) Subcommittee and a member of the House Financial Services where he serves as the Chair of the Subcommittee on National Security, International Development and Monetary Policy.

Jim lives in Greenwich with his wife Mary, and two daughters, Emma and Linley.
