Progressivism and Its Philosophical Origins (Thinking Critically About Political Life)



Dr. Khalil Habib has studied and now teaches the works of the Great Thinkers and seeks to make their Great Books come alive, enhancing the love of learning and the exploration of ideas. The works he explores have and continue to shape our civilization, our laws and institutions. He seeks to challenge ourselves in this way so that we may better attempt to answer:

- **How should one live?**
- **What is a good life?**
- **What is justice and how ought it to inform our political communities?**
- **What is a citizen?**

In his own studies, Dr. Habib links the history of political philosophy and philosophical literature; where wonder is the beginning of the quest for wisdom and self-knowledge and civil debate and conversation is essential to generating the desire for understanding.

Dr. Habib received his PhD in Philosophy at Boston University, a masters in political science at the University of Toronto, and a B.A (magna cum laude) at the University of Maine.

Dr. Habib is the Associate Professor of Politics at the Van Andel Graduate School of Statesmanship at Hillsdale College in Michigan.
