



## **Laurence Kantor**

### **“Prospects for the Economy and Markets in light of Recent Changes in Tax and Trade Policy”**



The news cycle today can seem overwhelming, with political news having become dominant. Meanwhile the economy and the stock market have performed extremely well. Are these trends likely to continue, and, if so, for how long? Putting politics aside, what are the facts around tax reform, trade policy and immigration and what are the economic and market implications?

Please join us to hear Larry Kantor, who will draw on his many years as a senior leader in the financial industry to tackle these issues. Larry was a 2016 Advanced Leadership Institute Fellow at Harvard University, and recently retired as Managing Director and Global Head of Research at Barclays. Based in New York, Larry was responsible for global research including economics, equities, interest rates, foreign exchange, emerging markets, credit and commodities. He was also a member of the investment bank Executive Committee and made numerous media appearances, including CNBC, Bloomberg TV and radio, The Nightly Business Report and CBS Evening News.

Larry joined Barclays in 2003 as Head of Economics and Market Strategy. Prior to that time he held several positions of increasing responsibility in academia, the government and particularly the financial industry. Currently he has signed on as a member of the Investment Advisory Council for Betterment, an online wealth manager with over \$12 billion in assets under management. He serves on the Boards of The Council of Economic Education (which advances education in economics and financial literacy in K-12), Economic Mobility Pathways (which gets families out of poverty and keeps them out) and Ideas42 (which uses behavioral science to solve social issues).

Larry received his PhD and MA in Economics from Ohio State University.
