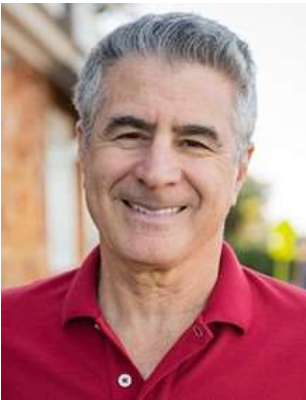

“The Economy, Financial Markets and the Fed: Where Do We Go From Here?”

While politics remains dominant in the news, the economy continues to roll on positively. The stock market fluctuates largely dependent on perceptions of the extent and duration of the imposition of tariffs on U.S. imports particularly from China. The Fed and the executive branch are at odds over the proper direction of interest rates. Immigration remains a contentious and divisive issue. So what's up?

Please join us to hear Larry Kantor, who will draw on his many years as a senior leader in the financial industry to tackle these issues. Larry has appeared on three previous occasions before the RMA and has received wide praise for his clear, concise and comprehensible views on national issues from an economist's perspective. Larry was a 2016 Advanced Leadership Institute Fellow at Harvard University following his retirement as Managing Director and Global Head of Research at Barclays where he was responsible for global research, including economics, equities, interest rates, foreign exchange, emerging markets, credit and commodities. He was also a member of the investment bank Executive Committee and made numerous media appearances, including CNBC, Bloomberg TV and radio, The Nightly Business Report and CBS Evening News.

Larry joined Barclays in 2003 as Head of Economics and Market Strategy. Prior to that time he held several positions of increasing responsibility in academia, the government and the financial industry. He recently signed on as an Operating Partner at Atlas Merchant Capital, a private equity firm run by Bob Diamond, former Chief Executive Officer of Barclays. He is a Board Member of the Investment Advisory Council for Betterment, an online wealth manager with over \$15 billion in assets under management. He also serves on the Boards of The Council of Economic Education (which advances education in economics and financial literacy in K-12), Economic Mobility Pathways (which gets families out of poverty and keeps them out), and Ideas42 (which uses behavioral science to solve social issues).

Larry received his Ph.D. and MA in Economics from Ohio State University.
