

The Pandemic Recession and Recovery: Implications for the economy and financial markets



Every business cycle is different, but we have never experienced anything remotely like the past 15 months. COVID19 produced the deepest recession in modern history, with much of the economy initially shut down. Over 22 million jobs disappeared in just two months – more than twice what were lost during the entire financial crisis. Following the incredibly rapid development and distribution of some of the most effective vaccines ever created, we can now see the light at the end of the tunnel. Along with historic fiscal and monetary support, this is now generating rapid gains in economic activity and asset prices, including stocks, houses and many commodities. The question now is how long this will last, and what the repercussions will be for the most rapid increases in public spending and money supply this country has ever experienced.

Please join us to hear Larry Kantor, who will draw on his many years as a senior leader in the financial industry to tackle the critical economic issues of the day arising from the pandemic. Larry has appeared on five previous occasions before the RMA and has received wide praise for his clear, concise and comprehensible views on national issues from an economist's perspective. Larry was a 2016 Advanced Leadership Institute Fellow at Harvard University following his retirement as Managing Director and Global Head of Research at Barclays where he was responsible for global research, including economics, equities, interest rates, foreign exchange, emerging markets, credit and commodities. He was also a member of the investment bank Executive Committee and made numerous media appearances, including CNBC, Bloomberg TV and radio, The Nightly Business Report and CBS Evening News.

Larry joined Barclays in 2003 as Head of Economics and Market Strategy. Prior to that he held several positions of increasing responsibility in academia, at the Federal Reserve and in the financial industry. Larry received his Ph.D. and MA in Economics from Ohio State University.
