## **Page Knox, Ph.D.**

### **"Leonardo at the Louvre"**



2019 marks the five hundredth anniversary of the death of Leonardo da Vinci, with numerous exhibitions large and small throughout the year commemorating this legendary artist. The celebration culminates in a once-in-a-lifetime retrospective currently at the Louvre which offers an exceptional display of paintings and drawings from museums and private collections worldwide. Dr. Page Knox will discuss some of his best known works in a lecture that examines the unique life and creative mind of one of the most renowned geniuses of all time. Having recently returned from Paris, Dr. Knox will reveal some of the new discoveries of the show and place the paintings and drawings in context, exploring how Leonardo's continual investigation of the natural world brought life to his exceptional body of work.

Page Knox is an adjunct professor in the Art History Department of Columbia University and a lecturer and educator at the Metropolitan Museum of Art. She works in a variety of capacities at the Met, teaching classes, giving public gallery talks and lectures on special exhibitions and the permanent collection, and leading tours for Travel with the Met. In keeping with her fascination with Leonardo, she led a trip last spring following the "Leonardo Trail" from Vinci to Amboise. This past October she took a group to Paris for an in-depth look at the Louvre's exhibition just before the show opened to the public.

Dr. Knox earned her B.A. in Art History from Yale University and her Ph.D. in Art History from Columbia University in 2012.
