Page Knox, Ph.D.
“Vincent Van Gogh and the Seasons”



What is it that draws people from all walks of life to Van Gogh's paintings of cypresses and orchards under the sun of a Provençal sky or the swirling clouds above a wheatfield in Auvers? Dr. Page Knox will discuss the universal appeal of Van Gogh's very personal search for salvation through his depictions of the changing seasons, as he sought to comprehend existence in the landscape and express it in his art.



Page Knox is an adjunct professor in the Art History Department of Columbia University and a lecturer and educator at the Metropolitan Museum of Art. She works in a variety of capacities at the Met, teaching classes, giving public gallery talks and lectures on special exhibitions and the permanent collection, and leading tours for Travel with the Met.

Dr. Knox earned her B.A. in Art History from Yale University and her Ph.D. in Art History from Columbia University in 2012.
