“Alice Neel: People Come First”



Join Page Knox for a discussion of “Alice Neel: People Come First,” a comprehensive survey of over 100 paintings and works on paper by one of the twentieth century's most prolific figure painters whose work champions the "under-represented." Inspired by a long-standing commitment to social justice, Neel painted activists for change throughout her career from the 1920s until her death in 1984. A longtime resident of New York, Neel captures and celebrates the dynamism of the city's streets and its citizens; as Neel stated in 1950, "For me, people come first. I have tried to assert the dignity and eternal importance of the human being."

Page Knox is a contractual adjunct professor in the Art History Department of Columbia University and a contractual lecturer and educator at the Metropolitan Museum of Art. She works in a variety of capacities at the Met, teaching classes, and giving public gallery talks and lectures on special exhibitions and the permanent collection. She is also highly active leading trips for Travel with the Met, and is scheduled to conduct the following tours:

- *Met Classics: Rome
- *Met Classics: Madrid
- *Great Artists—Caravaggio, Master of Light & Shadow: From Rome to Malta

Dr. Knox earned her B.A. in Art History from Yale University and her Ph.D. in Art History from Columbia University in 2012.
