Paul Kennedy, CBE, FBA

"Victory at Sea: Naval Power and the Transformation of the Global World Order in World War II"



In his book, *Victory at Sea* Professor Kennedy grapples with the rise and fall of the great powers in WW II. As a British historian he specializes in the history of international relations, economic power and grand strategies. In authoring more than ten books on the history of British foreign policy and great power struggles he has assessed the relationship between national economic power bases and military strength and strategies. In a prior book, *The Rise and Fall of the Great Powers* he evaluates this relationship on a world-wide scale over the past 500 years.

Professor Kennedy is the J. Richardson Dilworth Professor of British History at Yale University. He is also the Director of International Security Studies where he teaches Grand Strategy. He was elected to the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and the American Philosophical Society and was made Commander of the Order of the British Empire. Additionally, Professor Kennedy has lectured at the Institute for Advanced Studies at Princeton University and at the U.S. Naval War College.

He received his undergraduate degree from Newcastle University and doctorate from St. Anthony's College, Oxford.
