Sean McMeekin, Ph.D.
“Stalin’s War: A New History of World War II”



For the western allies World War II has always been Hitler’s war. But Hitler was not in power when the conflict erupted, his armies did not fight uninterruptedly in multiple theatres, and he did not inherit any of the spoils of war. Rather that central role belonged to Joseph Stalin. In this sense, the Second World War was really Stalin’s War.

Sean McMeekin, a prize winning historian, who drew upon recently opened Russian archives and materials in Poland and the Balkans, seldom examined by Western Historians, argues that the war’s true epicenter was in the east. While Hitler’s genocidal ambition may have unleashed the Armageddon, Professor McMeekin shows that the war which emerged in Europe in September 1939 was one that Stalin wanted, not Hitler.

Sean McMeekin is a professor of European History and Culture at Bard College. He has an A.B. from Stanford University, an M.A. and Ph.D. from the University of California, Berkeley and studied at the University of Paris, Moscow State University and Mezhdunarodny Universitet, Moscow. Among his other publications are *The Russian Revolution*, *The Ottoman Endgame: War, Revolution, and the Making of the Modern Middle East*, *The Russian Origins of the First World War*, and *History’s Greatest Heist: The Looting of Russia by the Bolsheviks*.
