“My Perspective on Foreign Affairs Today”



The Trump Administration has been in place for twenty-six months and has made numerous foreign policy decisions that break with the practices of past administrations. The withdrawal from multi-national agreements, the movement of the U.S. Embassy from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem, the disparagement of NATO and the European Union, and the high profile meetings and warm accolades for authoritarian leaders, including Vladimir Putin, Kim Jong-un, Mohammed bin Salman and Jair Bolsonaro, are initiatives that raise alarming questions about America's role as the leader of a liberal world order. Are these actions based on individual policy decisions or are they part of a coherent strategy that can be called the Trump doctrine?

Ambassador Niles will tap his 36 years of experience and insights in the United States Foreign Service and subsequent international relations to assess the current situation and how it affects our national interests and standing in the world.

He served as Ambassador to Canada (1985-89), Ambassador to the European Union (1989-91), Assistant Secretary of State for Europe and Canada (1991-93), and Ambassador to Greece (1993-97).

Ambassador Niles has since been President and Vice Chairman of the United States Council for International Business, which advances the global interests of American business both at home and abroad, promoting an open system of world trade, finance, and investment and is a member of the American Academy of Diplomacy. He is a resident of Edgehill in Stamford.
