Yascha Mounk, Ph.D.
**“The Great Experiment: Why Diverse Democracies
Fall Apart and How They Can Endure.**



Yascha Mounk will speak on his new book, *The Great Experiment – Why Diverse Democracies Fall Apart and How They Can Endure*, which examines how modern democracies have increasing numbers of groups identifying on race, political beliefs, and other factors. The resulting chaos is a challenge to the survival of fairness and order in society. Mounk believes that solutions to this challenge are at hand and playing out, though too slowly. There are policies and behaviors that can move us more quickly toward a more enduring model of democracy that, instead

of stumbling on diversity, embraces it. Mounk argues that this transition is the greatest experiment of our time.

Yascha Mounk is a political scientist known for his work on the rise of populism and the crisis of liberal democracy. Born in Germany to Polish parents, Mounk received his BA in history from Trinity College, University of Cambridge, and his PhD in government from Harvard University. He is now a Professor of the Practice of International Affairs at Johns Hopkins University and the founder of Persuasion. Mounk is also a contributing editor at The Atlantic and a senior fellow at the Council on Foreign Relations.
